I. Policy:

- A. In order for an individual to drive the ambulance or function as the primary patient attendant, an individual must be approved in advance.
 - 1. An individual may not work on a JPA ambulance until he/she has successfully completed the approval process.
 - 2. In order to successfully complete the approval process, the individual must provide valid documentation of the following license or certification:
 - a) CPR Card
 - b) California EMT-1 certification
 - c) California EMT-Paramedic License.
 - d) El Dorado County EMT/EMT-Paramedic Accreditation
 - e) If the employee is **not** a fulltime paid firefighter an Ambulance driver's license <u>is required by California Vehicle Code</u> and a Medical examiner's certification
 - 3. Each fire district is responsible to ensure that all individuals operation and /or serving as a primary patient attendants on JPA ambulances posses the required license(s) and/or certifications(s) and have successfully completed the approval process.
- B. An individual shall be approved to operate and/or serve as a primary patient attendant on a JPA ambulance upon successful completion of an orientation program which will consist of, at a minimum:
 - 1. Orientation to fire district's policies and procedures
 - 2. Orientation to JPA policies and procedures
 - 3. District evaluation of EMT skills during actual emergency responses
 - 4. Completion of the Emergency Vehicle Operators Course or equivalent (refer to policy #405).
- C. The individual's approval to operate and/or serve as a primary patient attendant on a JPA ambulance shall be continuous contingent upon satisfactory performance review and evaluation and all required documentation.
- D. JPA fire districts shall maintain documentation of an individual's satisfactory completion of all EMT/EMT-Paramedic approval requirements and shall make this documentation available upon request.

II. Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to define the process by which an individual is approved to operate and/or serve as primary patient attendant on JPA ambulances.
